**Mary Ann Levering Exline's Obit**

**Old Resident Died Sunday**

Mrs. Mary Exline, known to every one as "Grandma" died Sunday afternoon at her home in the south part of town. She was among the oldest residents of this vicinity, and had attained the age of 93 years.

Mrs. Mary Ann Levering Exline was born in Ohio, Sept. 4th, 1827 and died at her home in Long Island, Kansas, Sunday, December, 5th, 1920, at the age of 93 years, 3 months and 1 day.

At the age of 20 years she was united in marriage to J. E. Exline in Ohio. Twenty-four years ago she became a member of the Evangelical church at Eustice, Nebr, (1896)

She had been a resident of Long Island and Phillips County, Kansas since 1883. She was the mother of ten children, eight of whom are living, three being present at the funeral.

Funeral services were held Monday afternoon from the home and were in charge of Rev. F. A. Groves of the Methodist church. Interment was made in the city cemetery.
